The usual restrictions of size and media were set aside so that artists could create their meaningful pieces more freely. The paintings are hung in chaos representing the destructive and global nature of war. Interspersed are paintings representing peace. These paintings are quiet and beautiful and give the viewer a place to rest, as well as, reasons to hope for a brighter future. Inspiration for the design was taken from the famous American painter Robert Rauschenberg.
