Paintings unrelated to the theme will not be considered for acceptance.

Michael Kowbuz is an artist, teacher, and co-proprietor of Cerulean Arts Gallery & Studio in Philadelphia. He holds an MFA from PAFA and is the Director of Continuing Education Programs there. His drawings, paintings and prints are exhibited regionally and nationally.

Membership and Entry Fee

- GSWS Members: \$15 for 1st submission, \$25 for 2 submissions.
- Non-Members: \$30 for 1st submission, \$35 for 2 submissions.
- Artists must be at least 18 years old and reside in NJ, PA, NY or DE.
- Artists may submit up to two paintings. Only one painting may be accepted.

To submit as a member your GSWS Membership must be current (2023 dues paid.) Check membership status at gswcs.org/directory

Artwork Requirements

- The painted image, framed or unframed, must be no smaller than 10 inches or larger than 60 inches on any side.
- Paintings must be done in aqueous media: watercolor, acrylic, gouache, casein or egg tempera.
- Painting must be done on watercolor paper, YUPO, claybord or aquabord
- Use of pencil, ink or collage materials not created by the artist must not be dominant in the work.
- Artist original work only. No digital media, photography, prints or reproductions will be accepted.
- No submission may have been previously shown in any GSWS exhibition.

Traditional Framing Under Glass or Plexiglass

- Mats must be white or off-white. A small colored inner mat is acceptable.
- Framed works larger than 36 inches in either direction must be framed using plexiglass.
- All framed artwork must be wired and be ready for hanging, *no sawtooth brackets*.

Presentation Mounted (not under glass)

- Paintings on paper must be firmly adhered to a board or panel.
- Paintings must be sealed and/or varnished.
- Wood cradled panels must be at least 1½ inches in depth and have finished (non-raw) edges.
- Paintings must be wired and ready for hanging, *no sawtooth brackets*.
- Wood cradled panels may be wired using eye hooks screwed inside the cradle or D-rings on the back of the cradle.

Artist Statement

Artists are requested to include a brief statement (no more than 4 sentences) describing how his/her painting is related to the exhibition theme in the statement section on EntryThingy.

Digital Image Requirements

- Digital image file(s) must be in JPEG or PNG format. Maximum file size up to 5MB.
- Save image with a 300 dpi with 1950 pixels on the longest side.
- The image must be correctly oriented, vertical or horizontal.
- Show only the painted image, no mat or frame.
- No digital enhancement is allowed. Image must not differ from the artist's original piece.
- Name the image file: artist's **LastnameFirstinitial_Title.jpg**

Sale of Artwork

- All artwork **MUST be for sale** and available for the duration of the exhibition.
- 30% of the purchase price of sold art will be donated to the D&R Greenway, price artwork accordingly.
- A check will be sent to the artist within 30 days after the close of the exhibition.

Important!

Your EntryThingy profile and entry information must be accurate. Refer to the table below when entering information about your piece.

Artist name (found in account profile)	Your EntryThingy profile must have your name as you want it to appear. Pay attention to proper capitalization. Example: Sally Artist
Title	Type the painting Title as you want it to appear. Pay attention to capitalization, grammar, spelling etc.
Statement	Artists are requested to include a brief statement (no more than 4 sentences) describing how his/her painting is related to the exhibition theme in this section. Statements will be hung next to accepted paintings.
Description	Note: Traditional framing or Mounted (not framed under glass)
Dimensions	Painted Image Dimension - height x width in inches. Example: 26 x 17 (round numbers to the nearest inch, don't use "inch" marks, or 'h' or 'w' letters)
Materials	Enter the medium used in lower case only: watercolor, gouache, acrylic, etc. Example: watercolor, or acrylic and gouache
Price	Include a dollar sign. No comma or decimal point. Example: \$500 Please make note of the sale price. The label must match the entered sale price.
